Yale Requirements related to HIPAA Security Rule training

The HIPAA Security Rule requires that all individuals who handle protected health information in an electronic form complete training on the requirements of the Security Rule. In addition, Yale University policy requires that all faculty, staff, students in

- School of Medicine – Excluding the Departments of Cell Biology, Cellular and Molecular Physiology, Comparative Medicine, History of Medicine, Immunobiology, Microbial Pathogenesis, Molecular Biophysics & Biochemistry, Neurobiology, and Pharmacology)
- Physician's Associate Program
- School of Nursing
- Yale Health Services
- Department of Psychology clinics.

who use computing or communications systems during the course of work at Yale University, complete the online HIPAA Security training. A 'General' security training module is available for people who do not create, access or receive electronic protected health information (ePHI).

If you do not believe that this requirement is appropriate to your role at the University, please confirm that you do not conduct either of the following activities, sign this form and return it to your administrator.

- I do NOT create, receive, maintain or transmit Protected Health Information in an electronic form or provide IT support to someone who does in the performance of my University appointment.

AND

- I do NOT use computing or communications systems during the course of my work at the School of Medicine, School of Nursing or the University Health Plan. This includes Systems use on-campus as well as from remote locations, such as home, hotels and other off-campus locations and the use of a Yale e-mail account.
